

The Birds Nest Wellness Agreement:

The Birds Nest, Inc ("School") and the undersigned parents/legal guardian(s) ("Parents"), by entering into this Wellness Agreement ("Agreement") regarding the exclusion of their child ("Student"), executed by the Parents on the signed date, agree as follows:

1. **Consent:** This Agreement is entered into with mutual consent of Parents and the School.
2. **Exclusion Agreement:** Parents understand and agree that the Student may not attend School or must be picked up within one hour, if they a) exhibit symptoms of infectious illness or communicable disease (see Exclusion Criteria), b) have received routine immunizations, and/or c) do not seem well enough to take part in normal school activities. The School has the final say in determining if a Student should be excluded from school and/or when a Student may be readmitted to School.
3. **Exclusion Criteria:** The following criteria will be considered in determining exclusion from School:
 - A fever over 100°F
 - Inflammation of the eyes (excessive redness, glassy or discharge)
 - Jaundice
 - Vomiting
 - More than one incidence of diarrhea or loose stool which is not contained within clothing
 - Unknown sores/rash or head lice
 - Excessive coughing or nasal discharge
 - Pain (earache, cramps, body ache, headache, etc.)
 - Received routine immunizations
 - Not well enough to take part in normal activities (such as; overly tired or fussy)
 - Needs more care than teachers can give, and still care for the other children
4. **Readmittance Criteria:** The following criteria will be followed in determining whether or not the Student is ready to return to School. This gives the Student ample time to recover in the comfort of their home and helps stop the spread of illness to the other Students and staff.
 - No fever for 24 hours without a fever reducer
 - Antibiotics (if prescribed) has been used for a full 24 hours (48 hours in the case of strep)
 - Vomiting, diarrhea cleared for 24 hours
 - Open sores/rash has scabbed over or lice/nit free
 - Frequent coughing, excessive nasal discharge resolved
 - Pain (earache, cramps, headache, etc.) resolved
 - No adverse reactions and a full 24 hours have passed since receiving routine immunizations
 - Mood, appetite, behavior and activity are again normal
 - In some cases a physicians note and/or negative test results may be required
5. **Full Disclosure:** Parents understand and agree that they are required to notify the School if the Student will be absent and the reason for absence, including details surrounding the Students illness/symptoms (per DPHHS State Licensing). In the event that a Parent withholds information regarding the Students absence or that a Parent knowingly masked symptoms and sent an ill Student, the School reserves the right to terminate the Enrollment Contract effective immediately.
